ORDER


The Sub-Divisional Magistrate, DNH, Silvassa is pleased to grant permission for rally, public gathering and use of loudspeaker on date and place shown below as per the application dated 01.04.2019 referred in preamble (1) above:

This permission is granted subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. As per the directions of the Election Commission of India, the maximum number of Vehicle in the convoy of a candidate or accompanying him to come within a periphery of 100 meters of ROs / AROs Office shall be restricted to three.
2. The maximum number of persons who can be allowed to enter the office of RO/ARO at the time of filing nomination shall be limited to five (including candidate).
3. The Loudspeaker / PA system in the rally shall not exceed the permitted decibel limits as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court directions and shall not cause any inconvenience to the nearby residents and general public.
4. The organizer should not conduct Public Meeting, Dharna, Rally, use of loud speaker, slogan shouting etc. within the area of 100 Mtrs cover under section 144 of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
5. The organizer should not play loudspeaker near temples, Mosques, church and Hospitals etc.
6. The organizer will strictly follow the timings / venue as permitted.
7. The organizer should maintain law & order during the program.
8. The organizer should obey orders of Executive Magistrate / Police Officer.
9. The organizer should depute a liaison person and provide his details (with name and mobile number) in advance to police who can be contacted for instructions for the program.
10. The organizer should ensure that no problem or disturbance is caused to general public during playing loudspeakers.
11. There should not be any obstruction to the traffic or flow of traffic on any road. Organizer should make sufficient arrangements for parking at the place of programme for public attending function so that there is no any hindrance to general public.

12. The organizer should take all precautionary measures to prevent any mishap.
13. It will be overall responsibility of the organizer, if any incident occurs at the function.
14. There should not be any illegal activity like obscene / vulgar act during the program.
15. The organizer should submit list of volunteers to the undersigned and Police Station.
16. The rally members will keep moving and not halt at any place on route once started.
17. The rally will observe all traffic rules like wearing helmets / follow signals / no drunken driving / no rash and negligent driving etc.
18. If on foot, organizer will use ropes to clearly demarcate the pedestrian flow and avoid accidents.
19. The organizer should ensure that event is in compliance to guidelines of Model Code of Conduct and election process. Action will be taken for any act that is illegal / against rules.
20. There should not be any intimidation to any candidates or their supporters.
21. The Organizer shall be responsible for any untoward incident / breach of peace etc.
22. On road the rally shall occupy on 1/3rd of the width of the road and shall not cause any hindrance to normal traffic movement.
23. The Organizer & its worker should strictly follow the direction of Election Commission of India.
24. The organizer shall submit the details of the Expenditure Incurred to the Nodal Officer (Election Expenditure Monitoring) within 24 hours.
25. The organizer shall ensure that pictorial representation should be sober and moderate and of real educative value to voters.
26. The organizer shall ensure that high standard of decency and decorum should be maintained while making speeches or raising slogans.
27. The organizer shall ensure that vehicles that are being used for campaigning for the candidate is registered with the district administration, failing which, the campaigning shall be deemed as unauthorized campaigning which may attract penal provisions of Chapter IX A of IPC.
28. A public address system or loudspeaker or any sound amplifier, whether fitted on vehicles of any kind whatsoever, or in static position, used for public meetings for electioneering purposes, shall not be used at night between 10:00 p.m. to 06:00 a.m.
29. The organizer shall have adequate fire safety measures are taken during the program.
30. The organizer shall ensure that the program does not obstruct Traffic and vehicular movement.
31. The organizer has to co-operate with the Video Surveillance Team of Election deputed by the Returning Officer, D&NH Parliamentary Constituency.
32. The permission may be cancelled or revoked at any time, if, deemed fit by the undersigned.
